

## Information on the requirement of complete Vaccine history to attend EGUK Camp

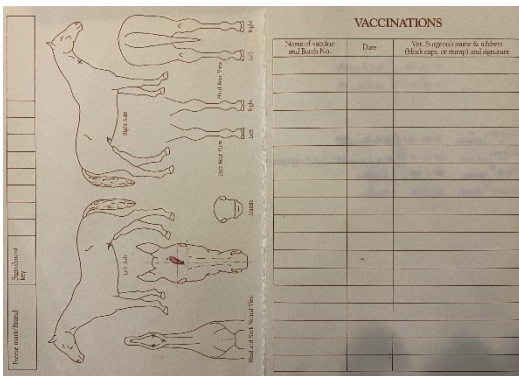
PLEASE EMAIL A COPY/PICTURE OF YOUR COMPLETE VACCINATION HISTORY SHOWING THE PRIMARY COURSE OF 3 VACCINATIONS FOLLOWED BY THE SUBSEQUENT BOOSTER VACCINATIONS TO DATE to [secretary@equestriangamesuk.com](mailto:secretary@equestriangamesuk.com)

As the EGUK camp is being held alongside the West Hants Camp, in order to adhere to the Pony Club Equine Influenza Vaccination rules to participate in **any** Pony Club event, camp or rally, horses/ponies must be fully vaccinated. ***This includes correct intervals when starting the vaccination course and a maximum of 12 monthly intervals between boosters.***

**Please ensure you bring your passport to camp. Random checks will be made.**

If any lapses to the required schedule have occurred at **any time**, the course will require restarting to comply with the pony club vaccination rules. ([2024-01-01-The-Pony-Club-Equine-Influenza-VACCINATION-RULE-2024-v7.pdf \(pcuk.org\)](#))

It is the owner's responsibility to ensure vaccinations are kept valid & up to date. Please remember passports should always travel with your horse/pony. These are required at camp and spot checks may occur at rallies and events.



Some horses/ponies may have their vaccination course started on the older style vaccination record (pre passports), if this is the case than a copy of this record is required as well current passport to show the primary course and annual booster until the passported records begins.



### Intervals Required for primary course

time between:

Vaccine 1 to Vaccine 2	21-92 days
Vaccine 2 to Vaccine 3	150-215 days
Annual booster	maximum of 1year

If starting a **new** course or **restarting** due to a lapse from **1<sup>st</sup> January 2024**

### Intervals Required for primary course

time between:

Vaccine 1 to Vaccine 2	21-60 days
Vaccine 2 to Vaccine 3	120-180 days
Annual booster	maximum of 1year

Horses and ponies must not attend activities within 7 days of receiving any vaccination. For clarity: no horse or pony may compete on the same day as a relevant injection is given or on any of the 6 days following such an injection.
