The following list is <u>for guidance only.</u> Remember to bring everything you think you or your pony will need during your stay at camp. The weather can be very changeable, please have all eventualities covered!

In order to ensure riders are wearing the most up to date riding hats, please note that from 1st January 2023, the following hat standards will no longer be accepted, due to the ageof hats made to these standards:

- 1. PAS O15 1998
- 2. SNELL 2001
- Jodhpurs
- Sweatshirts/Polo/t-shirts (to be worn when riding in addition to t-shirt provided.
- Clothes and suitable footwear for evening games
- Overalls/change of cloths for yard work
- Wellington boots for yard work

- Jodhpur boots (no chaps)
- Wet weather gear
- Toiletries
- Sun cream and hat
- Torch
- Warm jumpers
- Sensible shoes to wear in the barn covered toes, study soles
- Shoe cleaning kit
- Pencil and notebook
- Plate, bowl, knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon, mug, tea towel all in a named draw string bag
- Tack clean and in safe condition (please check stitching etc. in good repair)
   INSURED UNDER YOUR OWN POLICY
- Reins must be able to tie a knot in them (contact us for details)
- Rugs
- 2 x stable bandages 2 x gamgee for stable management
- 1 x lead rope
- 1 x headcollar
- 2 water buckets
- Feed bucket/bowl
- 2 or 3 hay nets (hay provided for camp but not the journey home
- Grooming kit hoof pick, solid hoof oil and brush, dandy brush, curry comb, body brush, sponge, water brush, stable rubber (cloth), all in a bag or box named
- Saddle soap, sponges, rags, all in a named bag.
- Wheelbarrow, stable fork stiff broom, shovel
- Hard feed marked in bins or bags with clear instructions! Please note even ponies not usually fed will need something.
- Insect repellent for ponies and for humans
- Bedding, sleeping bag, pillow and night clothes (it is cold in a tent so thick sleeping bag or extra rug.
- NB: No sharp knives (for cutting carrots etc)

<u>PLEASE</u> make sure you have everything you and your pony will need for the duration of camp and that is **all clearly labelled**. Make sure you have discussed any individual worries or requests beforehand with the organiser so that she can do her best to help you, rather than 'bombard' her with requests on what will be a hectic, arrival.

**Mobile Phones:** We will operate a strict NO MOBILE PHONES policy. In case of emergency there will be a mobile phone with the organisers which can be used.
